- Students minoring in entrepreneurship are limited to 30 hours of Bloch School courses.
- Students must achieve a minimum GPA of 2.25 in all entrepreneurship courses.
- All 18 hours must be completed at the Bloch School.
- Students have the option of replacing up to two entrepreneurship electives with two discipline-specific electives that are consistent with their entrepreneurial focus. These electives must be selected from an approved list of courses offered by the school that houses their major discipline.
